I am the only one who knows what is best.

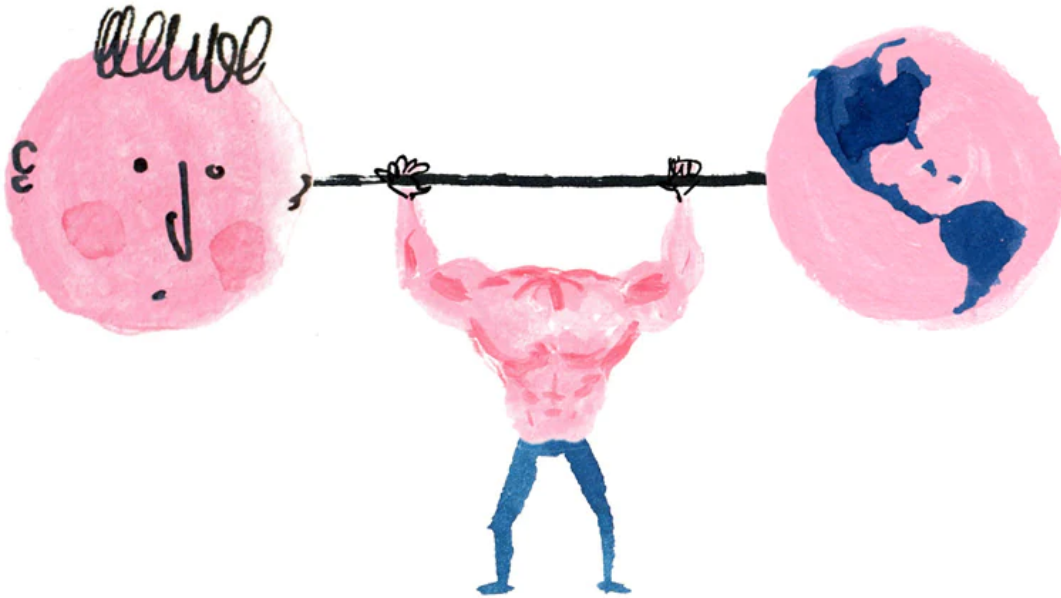
