Should psychologists prescribe?

- APA position is that we should;
- Today, it is really a question of when, not whether.
- I support the APA position...
- but I, personally, would not apply for such privileges.

Psychology's unique contribution:

- Does a particular Rx work for a particular condition?
- How does this Rx affect this individual child?

The Febrile Seizures study of phenobarbital

- we found this treatment had no main effect on seizures
- we found a significant negative side effect on IQ
- we changed standard medical practice

How you measure drug effect matters!

- Clinical impression 88% found (+) drug effect
- Rating scales 57% found (+) drug effect
- Neuropsych. tests 17% found(+) drug effect
- direct measure of behavior 41% found (+) drug effect
- n= 208 studies
